
Give 5 rescue breaths



Give CPR:

30 chest compressions
and 2 rescue breaths

for one minute



Compress 4 cm – blow until visible chest rise

Continue CPR

If AED available, attach and follow instructions

CHILDREN 1 YEAR TO PUBERTY

CHILDREN When children suffer a cardiac arrest it is usually caused by not being able to breathe normally. Give five initial breaths followed by one minute of CPR 30:2, before calling 112. Continue CPR 30:2

ADULT When adults suffer a cardiac arrest it is usually caused by life-threatening heart rhythm disorders. Call 112. Start CPR, 30 chest compressions and 2 rescue breaths, 30:2. If AED available, attach and follow instructions.
